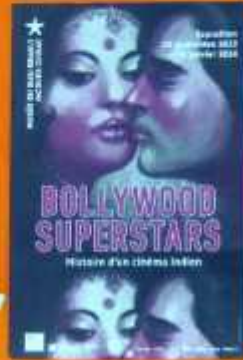


BOLLYWOOD

The name of Bollywood comes from a criticism that pointed to the mixed and colored India films, so he has called Bollywood (Bollywood). 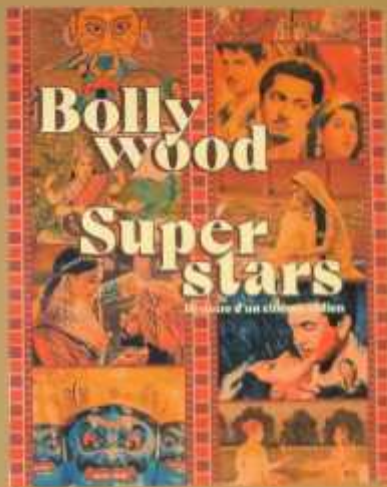

Bollywood is the North Indian film industry based in Bombay. It is the largest regional Indian film industry in terms of number of films produced. It has been compared

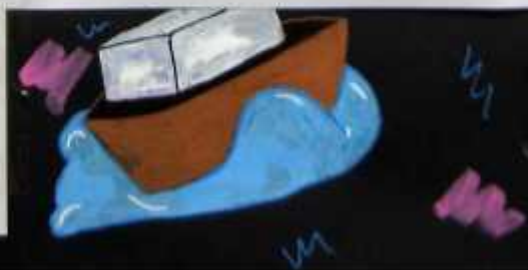

In India, cinema is not just an art or an industry, it is a culture, a living art, it is an integral part of the lives of many Indians of many cities who identify themselves with the actors ("heroes") and like to watch their movies.

Here is an example of a popular Bollywoodian movie: Mahabharat is a 1965 movie directed by Bhanu Pratap. This is a movie adaptation of Mahabharata. The movie is only about some parts of the original story.

Some gods may be present or just mentioned in the movie. The Vishnu, the protector, Krishna, an avatar of Vishnu, Drona and Jayana, the god of Sun, Drona is actually not a god but he has excellent skills in the handling weapons.

And here are some actors in the movie: Datta Singh, an actor, wrestler, and politician, Pradeep Kumar, an actor in the 50's, Ashu Bhattacharya, a veteran Bollywood actor, and Jeevan, a popular actor.

In the Indian religion, there are 2 main gods. There is Brahma, the creator, Shiva, the destroyer and Vishnu, the preserver. They are doing a kind of balance. Brahma creates the world, Shiva brought around like disaster and Vishnu fights against them. There is Surya too, but he is "only" the god of the sun. They all have weapons. The weapons are representing the gods to communicate with the people like Krishna, who is one of the ten avatars of Vishnu.

The Indians also used frescoes to illustrate their stories as they sang, danced and played music.

Most Bollywood films are imported by great Hindu mythological stories, like Ramayana which tells the story of Rama, the seventh incarnation of Vishu in seven volumes. Bollywood films try to respect the tunics and ancestral rites as best as possible as well as the dance and the music to tell the story better. The hands of the actress are colored in red so that we can see them when she does mudras. Bollywood is also appreciated by Hindus, because they can exchange a look with the gods to put oneself under the protection of him or her.

Nowadays Bollywood studios don't produce mythological films anymore. They produce super-heros film which are as amazing as Marvel's films. Special effects are very developed and if you look at a Bollywood film, you will see incredible cascades and fights. Bollywood studios also produce love stories. History of bollywood

- Bollywood has its origin in Mumbai (formerly Bombay), and the term is a contraction of Bombay and Hollywood. The word was popularised by an Indian journalist in the 1970s. Productions are shot in the Indian language and around 1,000 films are made each year.
- The first Indian speaking film, *Kam Akh*, produced and directed by Ardeshir Irani, was projected at the Majestic cinema in Bombay on 14 March 1913. It was a great success. The film was a great success. It has created the foundations for Indian cinema in which song and dance sequences take the main spaces.



The Music and the dance

- Movie music has its own regular composers, such as R.D. Burman, Jatin Lalit, Anu Malik, Madan Mohan, A. R. Rahman and Nadeem-Shravan. The style is a blend of Indian and Western music. Different industries

- The other two main industries are followed: the regional Telugu-language film industry - 192 films produced in 2011 - whose center is in Hyderabad, and Kollywood - 180 films produced that same year - whose Tamil-language films are shot in the outskirts of Chennai.
